### **Frequently Asked Questions**

1. I wish to import ham for Christmas, may I do so?

**Ans:** The importation of meats require a permit from the Ministry of Agriculture.

2. Can Red Kidney Beans be imported without a permit?

**Ans:** No, Red Kidney Beans require a permit from the Ministry of Agriculture.

3. My children wish to travel with their toy guns, are these allowed?

**Ans:** Toy guns are restricted as they are deemed as a threat and can be used for illicit purposes. The requisite permit is needed for importing theses items.

4. Can Camouflage (military) clothing be imported?

**Ans:** This gear is for military purpose or use only. It will be deemed as an impersonation or a threat, if civilians are caught wearing this type of clothing.

5. Do I need a permit to import the remains of my deceased relative?

**Ans:** A permit is required for the importation of all human remains (corpse or ashes).

6. Are fruits and vegetables restricted?

**Ans:** These items are restricted, in order to prevent the importation of pests or plant diseases. The requisite permit is needed from the Ministry of Health, before they can be imported.
